- Tomatoes repel the caterpillars that chew on cabbage leaves
- Onions, chives and garlic deter most pests and improves soil quality
- Radishes draw leaf-miners away from spinach to chew on radish leaves - which doesn't harm the radish underground
- Lettuce tenderises summer radishes
- Lavender is not only fragrant and a beautiful colour but it also helps deter pests like whitefly and moths and draws in helpful bees
- Mint is a super helpful garden companion deterring moths, aphids, ants and rodents. But it is invasive so make sure to plant it in its own container.
